I will definitely recommend it to my peers. Infact I would love to repeat the fellowship. I feel there is alot to learn from this fellowship. Also the guidance and support was really good.



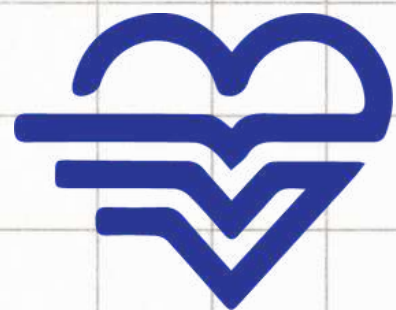

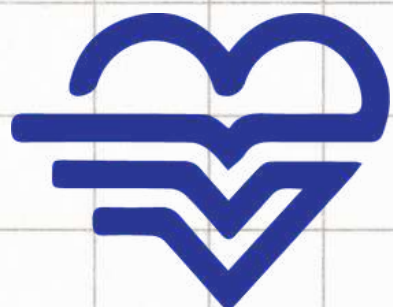

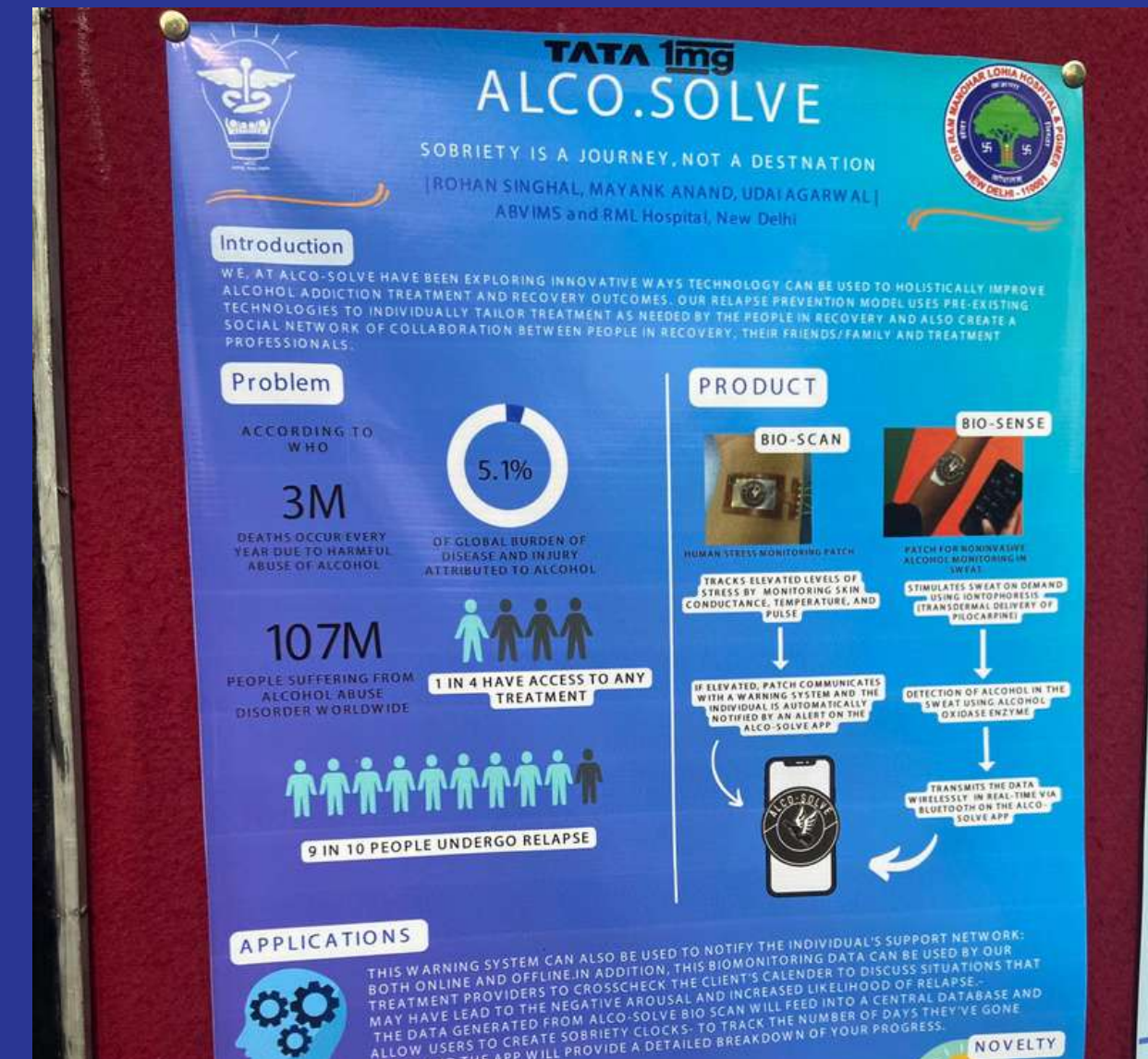

Impact beyond Fellowship



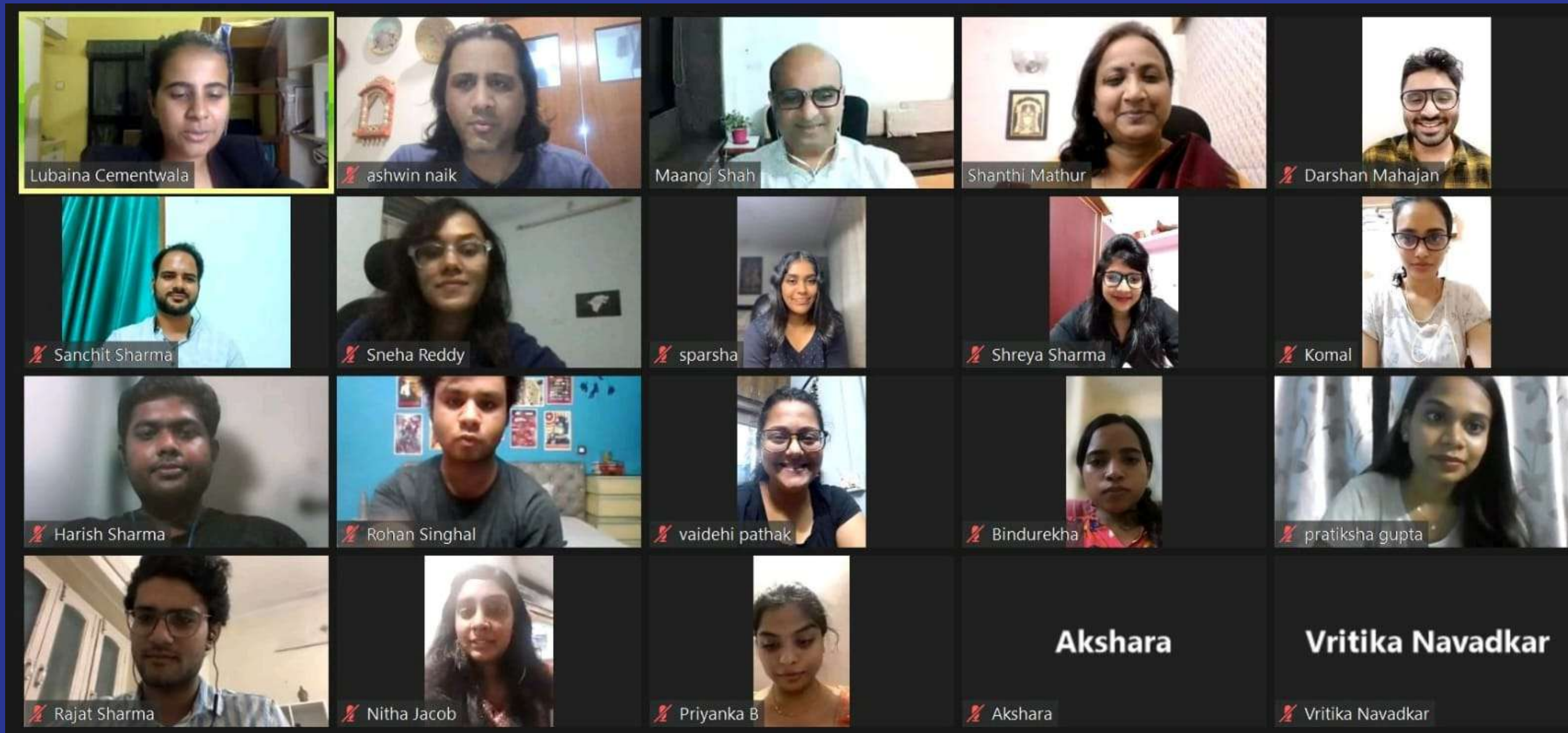

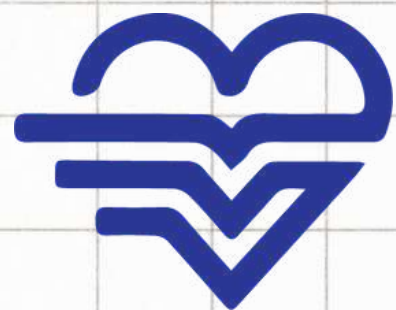
Plans ahead: Fellowship 2.0

We are working towards creating a more impactful fellowship/cohort to scale our impact and take the model of fellowship across India.

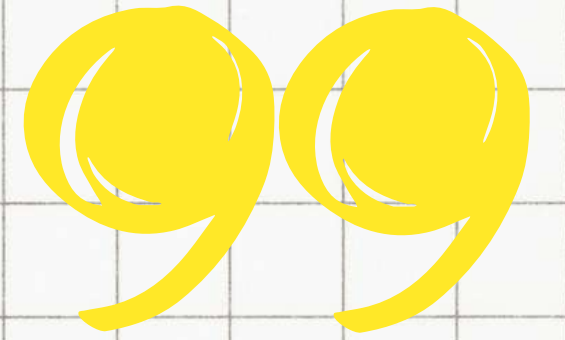

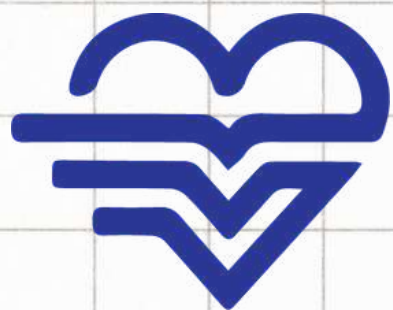

Fellowship 2.0 Recommendations



Well, there's only so much you can do with an online fellowship and I think this fellowship explored every possible aspect of that. I think the assignments given towards the very end of the fellowship could have been incorporated much earlier so that we could have gotten more time to work on them properly. I think the entrepreneurial solution assignment had a scope of being something much bigger, like a whole competition or event in itself. I think you could introduce an event like a sort of **hackathon** where fellows come up with innovative solutions to problem statements provided by you guys.



I think the time management, proper follow up and deadlines can be **managed better**. I felt time was short as we have to learn the activity from scratch.
