





Intended Learning Objective





A glimpse of the presentation competition (Fellows presented detailed presentation on a rural healthcare topic)



Fellowship 2.0 Recommendations

Well, there's only so much you can do with an online fellowship and I think this fellowship explored every possible aspect of that. I think the assignments given towards the very end of the fellowship could have been incorporated much earlier so that we could have gotten more time to work on them properly. I think the entrepreneurial solution assignment had a scope of being something much bigger, like a whole competition or event in itself. I think you could introduce an event like a sort of hackathon where fellows come up with innovative solutions to problem statements provided by you guys.

I think the time management, proper follow up and deadlines can be managed better. I felt time was short as we have to learn the activity from scratch.

I would prefer if we could be given a **transcript** of the weekly meetings or MOM of every meeting could be shared, just so we can review once.
